Red Badge to Blue Badge Qualification Form - Process

7.	REQUIRED: Attend at least one Club Board of Directors Meeting.
8.	REQUIRED: Attend at least one Rotarian Foundation of Livermore Board of Directors Meeting.
9.	REQUIRED: Serve as Club Greeter twice.
