COSTS OF MEMBERSHIP

ROTARY CLUB OF LIVERMORE

DUES - \$360 per year; may be paid semiannually (November/May).

FINES – All members are expected to donate \$50 to the Club at some time during the year, usually in the form of an “indulgence” or “fine”. Many members make a donation by joining the President’s Club for a cost of \$100 to The Rotary Foundation, \$100 to Rotarian Foundation of Livermore, and \$50 to the Club for a total of \$250. Donations to other Club interests, such as the Nepalese Children’s Fund and the Music Scholarship Fund are also accepted.

PASS THE HAT – Optional - On occasion, Members may be asked to donate to various causes.

MEETINGS – Cost of a meeting is \$20 for those who eat and \$5 for those not eating. The cost may be paid by club credit, credit card, personal check or cash.

FACILITY FEE - To cover facility costs, all members will be assessed an automatic charge of \$5 for each meeting of the club. For members attending a meeting, the charge will be part of the lunch cost as listed above. For members who do not attend the meeting, the charge will be applied against the member’s club account as listed in Club’s Financial Policy (#4).

FUNDRAISERS – Optional – Members are asked to support a number of fundraisers for club activities and the Foundations.
