

MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS 2019

The **Rotary Club of Livermore Music Scholarship Fund** was established in 2001 to provide financial aid to young music students in Livermore. If you are a music student, and are currently enrolled in a Livermore middle school or high school, you are eligible to apply for a scholarship.

This year there will be a number of scholarships of \$100 up to \$500 each awarded to middle and high school students. An outstanding high school senior **may** be awarded up to \$1,000.

To apply for a Music Scholarship, fill out the attached application and send it, along with a **2 to 3 minute mp3 recording of your playing or singing (no more than 6 MB)**. If you play more than one instrument choose your best one. Send to:

Any student not submitting all the information above as described will be disqualified.

All applicants will be notified by e-mail of your acceptance or denial.

Awardees will be notified by April 10th. Up to 3 awardees may be asked to present a short performance at the awards ceremony.

The awards ceremony will be held at the Rotary Club of Livermore's luncheon meeting on Wednesday, April 17, 2019.
