### 30. Corporate Membership

The Rotary Club of Livermore offers a Corporate Membership program for corporations and businesses.

1. **Qualifications** – Any corporation or business registered in the State of California, doing business in the city of Livermore, is eligible for Corporate Membership in the Rotary Club of Livermore.
2. **Members** - The Lead Designee of the Corporation is a member of the Rotary Club of Livermore and may appoint three persons to be his alternates.
3. **Designees** - The Corporation's Lead Designee must be a member of the Corporation's senior management; the alternates can be managerial individuals employed full time by the corporation.
4. **RI registration.** District and RI dues will be paid for the Lead Designee. The Lead Designee will be listed as an official member of the Rotary club of Livermore, and the alternates will be listed as other members and noted as designees of the named eligible Corporation.
5. **Attendance.** It is recommended that the Lead Designee attend in person at least twice per year. Other attendance and participation expectations of the Club may be met by any of the designees.
6. **Badges.** The Lead Designee and all alternates shall be given special badges denoting their status as Corporate Members. Given that they may be assigned on a rotating basis, they will not go through the blue-to-red badge conversion process, but a reduced set of activities will be prescribed by the Membership Committee with input from other club officers.
7. **Votes and Quorum.** For the purpose of general meetings and club matters, the Corporation shall have only one vote, which will be made by the Lead Designee attending the meeting at which the vote is taken.
8. **Holding office.** The Corporate alternates shall not be eligible to be an officer or member of the Board of Directors of the Club. All designees are expected to participate in club activities. They are allowed to be committee chairs with the exception of the Foundation, Membership and Public Relations committees.
9. **Dues.** Dues for the Corporation shall be established to cover costs for all designees, starting at \$1000 in 2023 and adjusted as appropriate.
