The **Rotary Club of Livermore Music Scholarship Fund** was established to provide financial aid to young music students in Livermore. If you are a music student, and are currently enrolled in a Livermore middle school or high school, you are eligible to apply for a scholarship.

This year there will be a number of scholarships of \$100 up to \$500 each awarded to middle and high school students. An outstanding high school senior may be agarded up to \$1000.

NEW! After review of all applications, you may be asked to meet with our Rotary Committee for a Live Audition. You will be required to perform in front of a small informal group of Rotarians for 5-10 minutes. If necessary, you may bring an accompanist.
